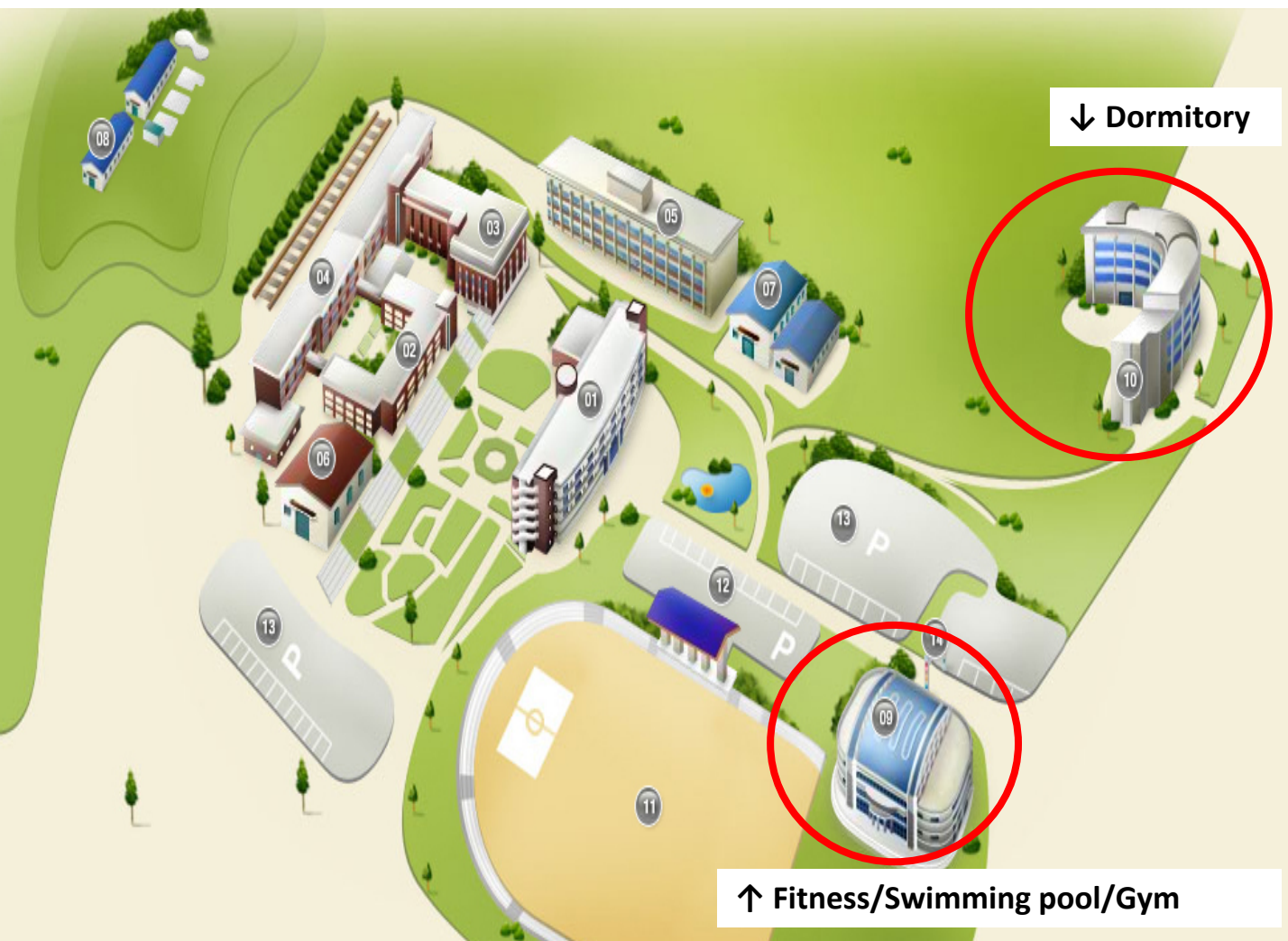
# Venue - Fields Map

# Women's Qualifying

---

## *World Qualification Round Robin*

*4 teams will be competing in a round robin format over the first 4 days to determine which 2 teams qualify for the 2021 Women's World Cup. These teams are China, Chinese Taipei, Hong Kong and Korea. In addition, these games will also be part of the ASPAC round robin tournament.*

*The placement in this round robin will determine the order of play in the subsequent games. QF1 and QF2 are the two countries that qualify.*

*All games played under full FIL rules as published, including times, sudden victory etc.*

*2 Points for a win. No draws.*

*Where teams are tied on points then placement will be determined by the result of the game between the tied teams. If this is not sufficient then the Goal Differential Formula will be applied to determine placement:*

*$(\text{Goals For} - \text{Goals Against}) / \text{Total Goals}$*

*In the formula, the scores of all the games in the Round Robin of the tied teams are used. The maximum difference in scores allowed per team will be 12, which is achieved by reducing "Goals for". Actual scores are used except those matches where the goal difference exceeds 12. In these cases, the goal difference is reduced to 12.*

- In the event of the score being tied at the end of regulation playing time
- 2 mins break( Coin-Toss )
- Sudden Victory :
  - When one team get a goal, game will be finished immediately.
  - The teams shall change ends between overtime periods(4mins).
  - All periods of overtime shall start with a face-off/draw.

# Payment Method

---

## Invoice

The package price/amount is calculated in Korean WON(KRW).

The first step is to fill out the registration application and send it to KLA via e-mail. We will issue your team's invoice.

Once you receive the invoice, you can use the account information below to send the participation fee. KLA will send you a receipt showing your balance immediately upon receipt of your payment.

If you cannot send Korean WON directly from your country, please request to KLA for a USD invoice. (Please note that the exchange rate for USD invoices is KRW 1,100 per USD 1.) Should you send funds in US dollars, you will receive the receipt showing your balance as described above(calculated as the amount of your payment immediately in Korean currency).

Once final remittance has been completed, the KLA will send final account balance. In the event that the total remittance amount has exceeded the invoice amount, KLA will refund the excess amount in cash while the team is in Korea.
